Question Box 1

- Which details support the key idea? Look for the who? What? When? Where? Why? How much? How many?
- What is the central message in SciGirls Stories: Latinas at Work? Explain?
- What is the author trying to say through SciGirls Stories: Latinas at Work?
- What is STEM?
- How are the women in this episode STEM superstars?
- How do these women celebrate their heritage and culture?
- How does each incorporate their passion in their work and hobbies?

Question Box 2

- What surprised you in the program, and why?
- What's the most important thing you learned from SciGirls Stories: Latinas at Work?

- What in the program made you curious? Explain.
- What did you learn from the program?

- Research and describe a STEM job that would be more important for a woman to have instead of a man.
